Signs shall read "Danger, Thin Ice," and shall be of sufficient size to be readable at a distance of not less than one hundred and fifty (150) feet and shall be equipped with reflectors and color-coded in a pattern unique for this purpose only. Sign Design for Aqua-Therm Compliance

The dimensions and color of the below sketch are those required for compliance with RSA 270:33, effective Nov. 1, 1973, New Hampshire Department of Safety, Division of Safety Services.

All darkened areas shall be red or international orange in color.

DANGER = 3 inch letters THIN ICE = 1 3/4 inch letters

White and red diamonds, each 2 inches wide
