Dear LRM Inc, DBA The Mug Restaurant;

You are hereby notified the following decision was made by the Center Harbor Planning Board at their meeting on May 24, 2022.

Non-Residential Site Plan of property located at 62 Daniel Webster Highway; Center Harbor Application Case #2022-0524.A has been **APPROVED WITH THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:**

1. Outside seating is allowed from May 15th to October 20th
2. A more robust fence arrangement is to be installed for safety purposes
3. Consistent with the existing outdoor seating capacity approval, up to 53 people are allowed in the outside area
4. If outdoor lighting is required in the future, an amended site plan will be required.

Any change to the proposal as stated by the applicant and as submitted in the application, as written and approved minutes which are the official record of the hearing held on May 24, 2022 and as reflected in this notice of decision, shall require additional Planning Board approval(s).

If the approved plan is violated in any way, the property owner may be subject to penalties as outlined in the **Non-Residential Site Plan Section 3:4:11 Penalties**: **In case of violation of this Ordinance the Selectmen of the Town of Center Harbor may institute any appropriate action or proceeding to prevent such violation; to restrain, correct, or abate such violation; or to prevent the unlawful occupancy or any building, structure, or land. Any person, firm, or corporation which violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not more than two hundred seventy-five (\$275.00) dollars per day for a first offense and five hundred (\$500.00) dollars per day for subsequent offenses. The Town through its solicitor or other official designated by its Selectmen may recover the said penalty by civil action (RSA 36:27 rev. 1970).** **Amended May 24, 2022**

Please note that any party to the action or any person directly affected has a right to appeal this decision to Superior Court within 30 days. See New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, Chapter 677, available at the Town Office during regular business hours and on the State of New Hampshire website should you have any questions.

This notice has been placed on file and made available for public inspection in the records of the Planning Board on May 31, 2022. All departments or agencies where this decision is deemed relevant or necessary, will be issued a copy of this Notice of Decision.
